Non-Solicitation Policy

Revised and effective: February 3, 2025

The Iowa Cancer Consortium believes in the meaningful exchange of information to improve cancer control efforts and provide value to its members. This policy guides how member data and information are used for these purposes. Members and partners can contact staff at staff@canceriowa.org to discuss working together or for guidance on appropriate engagement.

In alignment with the Consortium's mission, vision, and values:

- The Consortium generally discourages the use of member information, member forums, workgroup and/or committee meetings, and other Consortium platforms or communications for external commercial purposes, product development, or marketing commercial products. This does not include exhibiting activities at the Iowa Cancer Summit.
- The Consortium prohibits sharing member contact information obtained through its platforms with non-members without prior approval.
- Selling products to patients, caregivers, and lay people for commercial gain is not allowed on Consortium platforms or within Consortium activities. (For example, exhibitors at the Iowa Cancer Summit are not allowed to sell merchandise at their tables.)

The Consortium staff and board will decide if actions break this policy. If organizations or individuals violate this policy, they might lose access to Consortium directories, forums, and other platforms.

This and other Iowa Cancer Consortium policies align with our commitment to inclusion and respect for all individuals. Our approach is one of openness and shared humanity. We strive to create a space where diverse voices, bodies, and brains are welcomed and valued. We ensure every person's unique story and connection to cancer are met with unwavering support. Together, we are building a stronger network that better reflects and includes all of Iowa's communities.
